Eligible HBV CPD Activity Examples

- Attending ASHM Hepatitis B courses – 1-3 HBV CPD points depending on the course.
- View pre-recorded education sessions – you can watch some ASHM education sessions after the event. 1 HBV CPD point.
- Using the REACH-B Advice form – 1 HBV CPD point per form submission with a maximum of 2 HBV points per year able to be claimed for prescribers who use the REACH-B Advice form multiple times.
- External education providers – if you have attended a conference, webinar or education session specifically about hepatitis B, this may be eligible for ASHM HBV CPD points. Approximately 1 point per hour of engagement. Please submit this with any supporting documentation via the [prescriber portal](#).
- Online learning modules – undertake activities and modules about hepatitis B on the ASHM LMS.
- Demonstrated engagement with your linked specialist – 1 HBV CPD points/hour of discussion
- Becoming or Renewing ASHM Membership – 1 HBV CPD points
- Attendance at a HBV-related conference – 1 HBV CPD points/day
- **Sitting on an HBV-related committee that is eligible for CPD** – 1 HBV point per committee with a max of 2 HBV points per year able to be claimed for prescribers who sit on more than one committee.

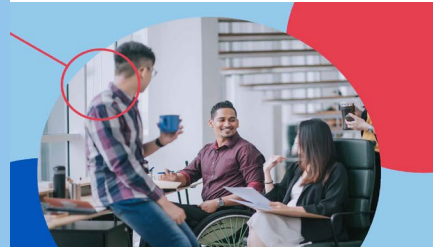

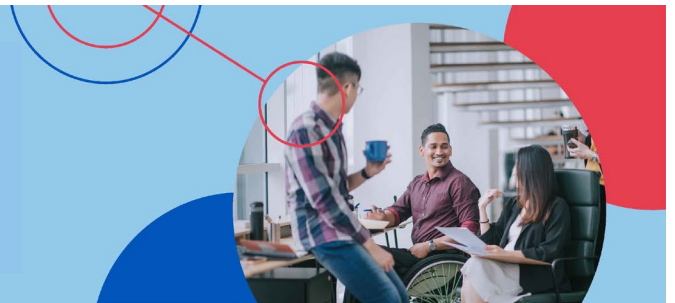
The Hepatitis B Prescriber Forum is a half-day forum designed for hepatitis B s100 prescribers that will cover current and relevant sector priorities and topics with expert
