We have a range of individual membership options available tailored to your occupation and needs.

Medical Ordinary

\$235/year

For medical professionals and other individuals located within Australia and New Zealand/Aotearoa with a professional interest in HIV, viral hepatitis, sexual and reproductive health, or any other related conditions.

Nursing Ordinary

\$110/year

For nursing and midwifery professionals located within Australia and New Zealand/Aotearoa with a professional interest in HIV, viral hepatitis, sexual and reproductive health, or any other related conditions.

Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander Ordinary

\$110/year

For Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander health professionals located within Australia and New Zealand/Aotearoa with a professional interest in HIV, viral hepatitis, sexual and reproductive health, or any other related conditions.

Pharmacists Ordinary

\$110/year

For community, retail, and hospital pharmacists located within Australia and New Zealand/Aotearoa with a professional interest in HIV, viral hepatitis, sexual and reproductive health, or any other related conditions.

Retired

\$66/year

For healthcare professionals with an ongoing interest in the HIV, viral hepatitis, sexual and reproductive health, and related sectors who have previously been an ASHM Ordinary member for five or more consecutive years and are retired from full-time employment.

Individual Sustaining

\$235/year

A non-voting membership category for individuals who are currently employed by the pharmaceutical industry, individuals residing outside of Australia and New Zealand/Aotearoa (excluding low to middle income countries), or those individuals who do not wish to influence policy.

International from LMIC

\$110/year

For medical professionals and other individuals from low to middle income countries (LMIC) with a professional interest in HIV, viral hepatitis, sexual and reproductive health, or any other related conditions.

Student

Free of charge

For full-time students located within Australia and New Zealand/Aotearoa, who are currently undertaking an area of study relevant to HIV, viral hepatitis, sexual and reproductive health, or any other related conditions. Proof of current enrolment as a full-time student required.
