Upon successful completion of this free training and the associated case assessment, eligible participants may apply to the relevant state departments of health for authority to prescribe Section 100 (s100) drugs for the management of hepatitis B in Australia. This course was previously known as 'Hepatitis B s100 Prescriber Course' and has been renamed. This name change more accurately reflects the scope of hepatitis B management in primary care and alignment with sector needs and advocacy priorities. Importantly, the content of the course has not changed, and eligible participants will receive their HBV s100 accreditation following completion of all course requirements
