Syphilis rates are rising across Australia, with the situation declared a Communicable Disease Incident off National Significance. Urgent Care clinic and emergency departments are critical points for detection, often seeing priority populations and people with limited access to primary care. This panel discussion will explore practical insights and approaches to syphilis management in urgent and emergency care settings.
