Staff in services supporting these women are well placed to support timely access to STI testing, treatment and care.

With support from SESLHD and SLHD, this free one-hour webinar is designed for staff working in specialist homelessness services across NSW and aims to build awareness of STIs and confidence in supporting vulnerable women's access to sexual health care.
